



In pursuance of a Warrant for 400 acs dated the 21th day of April A.D. 1794 was surveyed the 28th day of January 1817 for Philip Rose the above discribed Tract of Land containing 426 acres 124 perches & allowance of six per cent for Roads &c. and that the same was divided as above stated, between Owen David and Joseph Clark the assignees of the said Philip Rose for the purpose of obtaining separate Patents & at the time of making said survey the said Owen David was in possession of the same and there appered to be upwards of 12 acres cleared and fenced and a house fit for the habitation of man. Situate in venango Township Crawford County Pa.
