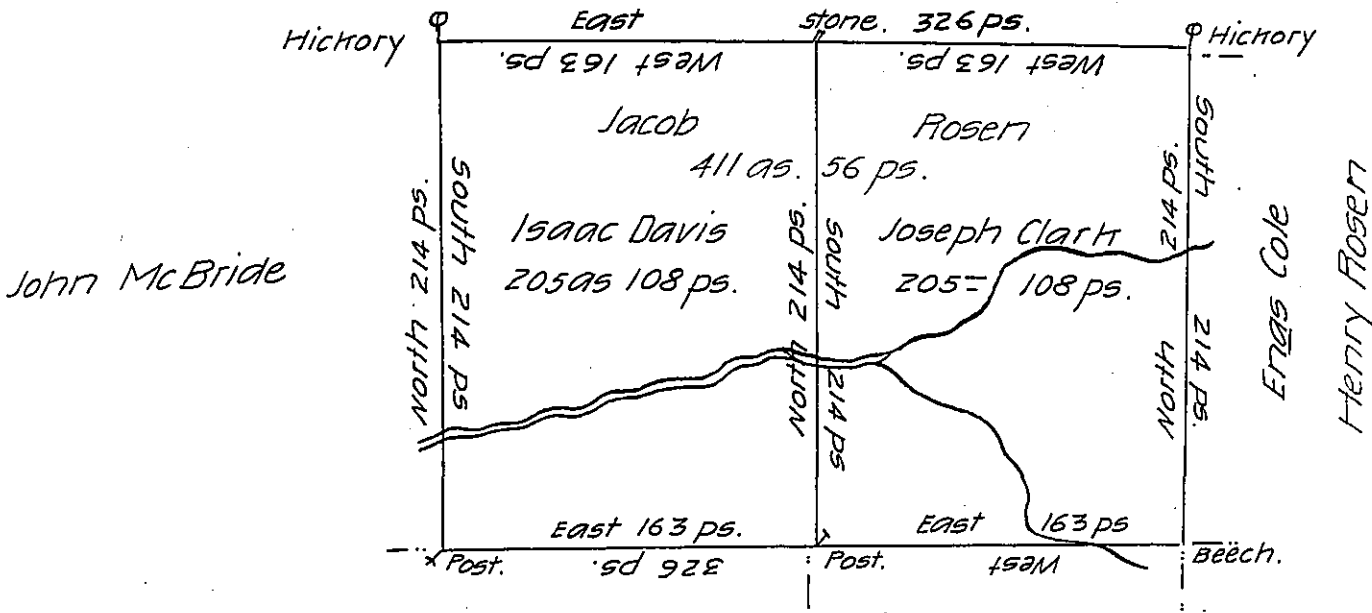

In Pursuance of a Warrant for 400 as. dated the 21th day of April A.D. 1794 was surveyed the 29th day of January 1817 for Jacob Rosen the above discribed Tract of Land containing 411 acres 56 perches and allowance of six per cent. for Roads &c. and that the same was divided as above stated between Isaac Davis & Joseph Clark the assignees of the said Jacob Rosen for the purpose of obtaining seperate Patents, & at the time of making said survey the said Isaac Davis was in possession of the same and there appered upwards of 20 acres of land cleared and fenced & a house fit for the habitation of man, situate in Venango Township Crawford County Pennsylvania
