



*A draft of forty nine acres and twenty perches of land with six per cent for roads, which appears from official papers to have been surveyed 16th March 1817 in pursuance of a Warrant to Michael Pitts dated 3d May 1794 situate in Wayne township, but was thought at the time of the date of the warrant to have been in Derry township, in Mifflin county. Examined 8th April 1820*
