



Situate in Fairview (formerly Newbury) Township in the County of York, Containing as above set forth 149 a. and 97 Perches and Allowance & c. Being part of a larger Tract of Land which was Surveyed by Charles Lukens late D.S. on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of March A.D. 1783. In Pursuance of a Warrant for 500 a. Granted to William Passmore dated the 1<sup>st</sup> day of December Anno Domini 1743. Resurveyed and divided off from the said larger Tract of Land for Joseph Fettrow the present owner the 12<sup>th</sup> day of October A.D. 1809.
