Surveyed by William ~~Mathews~~ Kersey late D.S. on the 11<sup>th</sup> of the 11<sup>th</sup> Month 1792. In Pursuance of a Warrant for 25<sup>a</sup> Granted to Richard Webb bearing date the 4<sup>th</sup> day of September Anno Domini 1786. And now at the request of the owner Richard Webb, I am desired to make return of the Draught as Calculated Examined &c the 22<sup>d</sup> day of August A.D<sup>e</sup> 1809.
