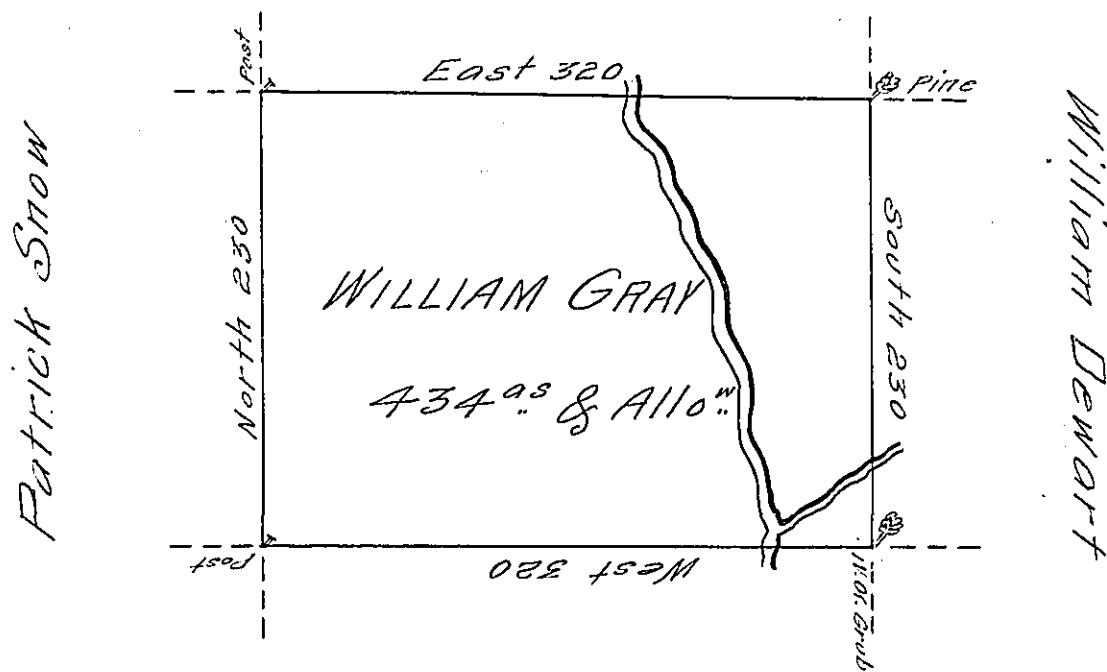


## Moses Hail
