



Situate in Shrewsbury Township in the County of York Containing as above set forth 124 1/2 & 76 P 1/2 and the usual allowance of 6 Per Cent for Roads & originally Surveyed by William Mathews late D.S. on the 16<sup>th</sup> of the 1<sup>st</sup> Month 1767. for Nicholas Biery In Pursuance of a Warrant Granted to Casper Repanick bearing date the 31<sup>st</sup> day of May A.D. 1762 then said to be Improved 60 Years. Resurveyed by the ancient marked lines and the Errors Corrected on the 19<sup>th</sup> day of February AD 1817 agreeable to an Order of the Honourable the Board of Property bearing date the 1<sup>st</sup> day of January AD 1817. Granted in favour of George Klinefetter the present owner who desired the same to be Returned for Confirmation.
