



In pursuance of a Warrant for 400 acres dated the 21<sup>st</sup> day of April A.D. 1794 was surveyed for James Ross the 4<sup>th</sup> day of March 1817 the above described tract of Land containing 425 acres 76 perches & allowance of six p<sup>er</sup> Cent for Roads &c. and that the same was divided Between John Jacob Hite (Senior) and Joseph Clark of the city of Philadelphia as above stated and at the time of making said survey the said Hite. was in possession of the same and there appeared to be Cleared and fenced upwards of 25 acres of the Land and a house barn &c. and that the same is in venang township Crawford County Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
