



A Draught of two Tracts of Land situate in Codorus Township in the County of York the Tract marked with the Letter AA Containing one hundred and eleven Acres and seventy Perches and the Usual Allowance of six Acres P Cent for Roads &c^e being part of a larger Tract of Land Containing one hundred & ninety two Acres & 100 P^e & Allowance Surveyed in pursuance of two Applications N^o 2340 & N^o 2343 Granted to Michael Newman Dated the 14th of January 1767 and the Piece marked with the Letter B being part of a larger Tract of Patented Land Containing 59^{ac} & Allowance But now Resurveyed by the old Lines and divided off to Michael Schmeisser Esq^e by consent of all the Parties concerned the 27th Day of January 1789. the part B not to be included in the Pet^e for Patenting described it by the dotted lines.
