



Surveyed January 12<sup>th</sup> 1833 for Samuel Perry the above described piece of land containing one acre and twenty seven perches with an allowance of six P cent on his warrant dated March 16<sup>th</sup> 1786 situate late in Salem now Washington Township in the County of Westmoreland

P- Isaac Moore --

I authorized Mr. Isaac Moore to make the above described small survey of one acre & 27 perches and the usual allowance the same being part of a survey as returned by John Moore D.S. made 29<sup>th</sup> March 1787 on a warrant granted to Samuel Perry dated 16<sup>th</sup> March 1786 said to contain 32<sup>95</sup> 23 perches & 0 situate in what is now Washington township Westmoreland County
