



Situate on the waters of the east branch of French Creek in district No. 1 surveyed the 4th day of June 1799 in pursuance of a warrant of the Surveyor Genl. (upon an order of the board of Property) dated the 12th day of May 1799 and a warrant in the name JahU. Parks dated the 10th day of April 1793, containing four hundred & eighteen acres & one hundred & forty seven perches and the allowance of six per cent
