



Situate on the waters of the east branch of French Creek in District No. 1 surveyed the 15<sup>th</sup> day of June 1799 in pursuance of a warrant in and a warrent of the Surveyor Genl. (upon an order of the Board of Property) dated the 16<sup>th</sup> day of May 1799 the name of Isaac Pim dated the 10<sup>th</sup> day of April 1793, containing four hundred & thirty acres & one hundred & forty four perches and the allowance of six per cent
