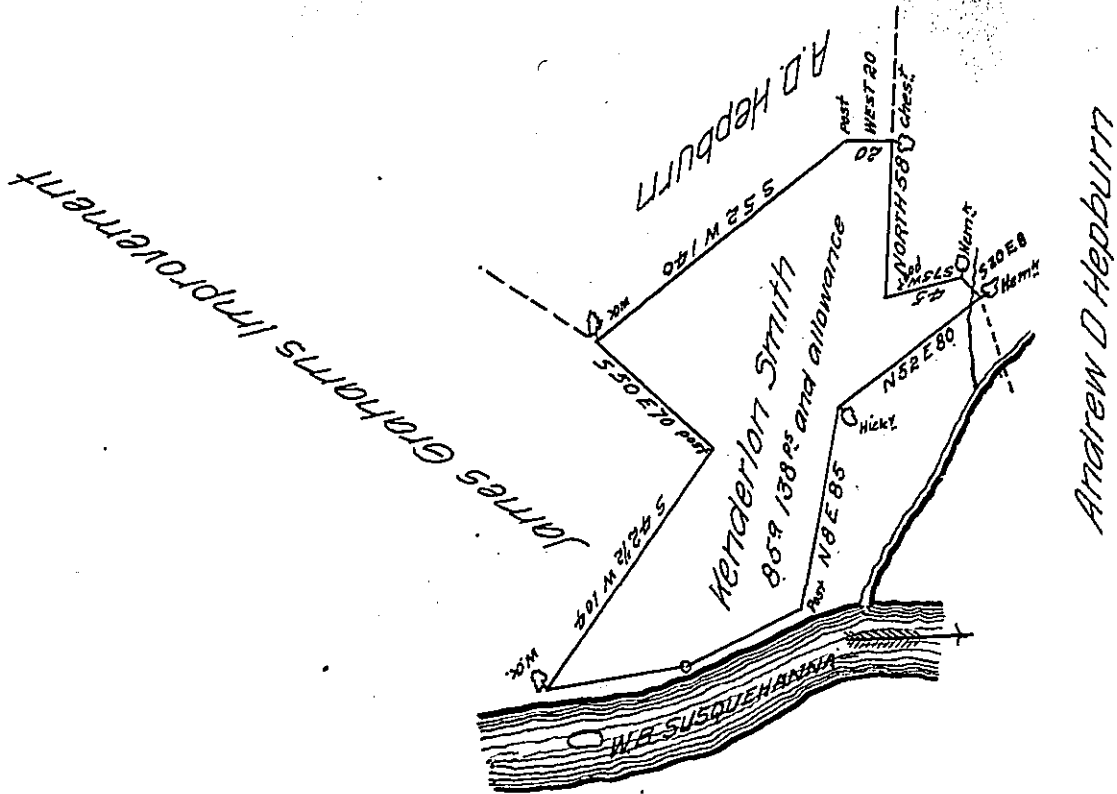


Courses down the river from the W.O.
