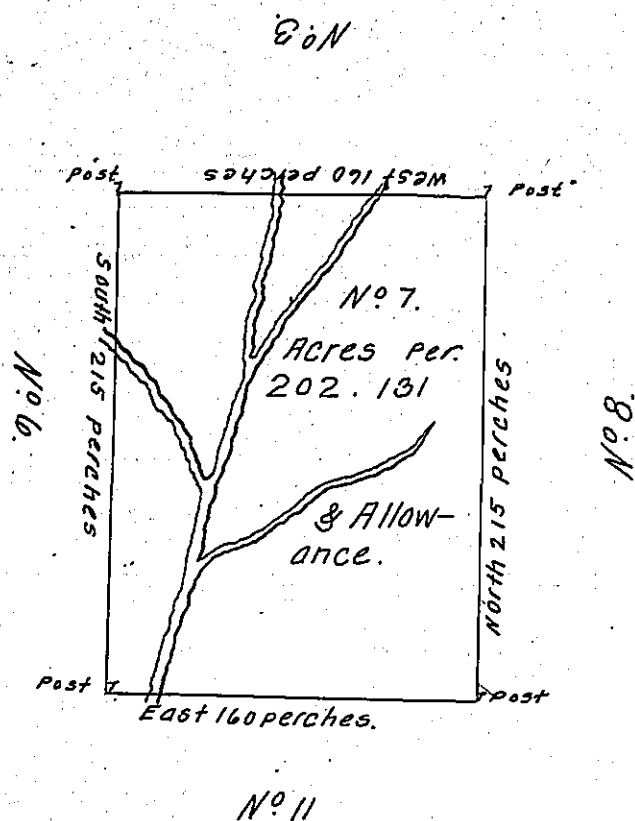


Part of District No. 3.
