



Situated on Two Mile Run a Branch of Beaver River that empties into Beaver- on the West Side 2 Miles above Fort Mackintosh in District No. 1. being the 5th Survey Westward of the Division Line of said District & No. 2 in the 1st Parallel South of the 4th Mile Square from the Northern Boundary of That Tract of Country appropriated by Law for the Redemption of the Certificates of Depriciation &c. and Surveyed in the month of June 1785. Pursuant to Instructions from John Lukens Esq. Surveyor General of the State of Pennsylvania.
