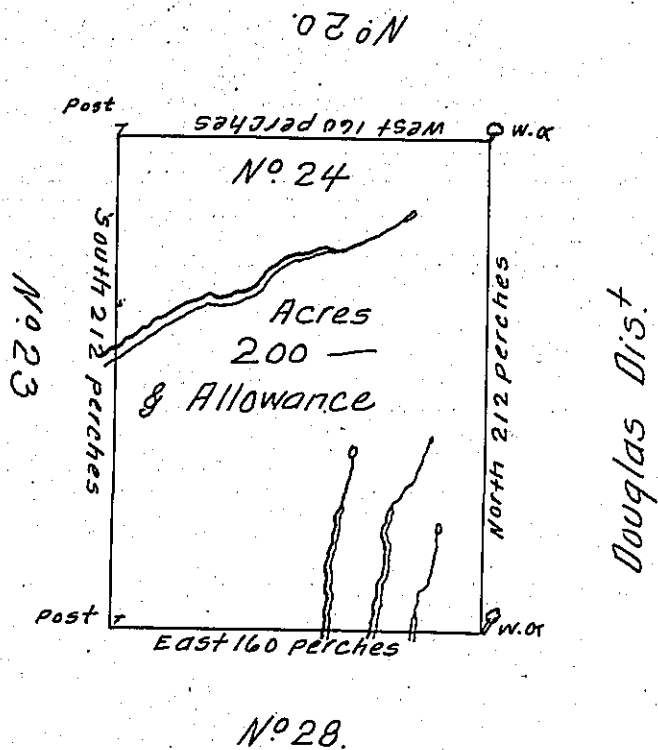


Part of District No 3



In pursuance of An Act of Assembly passed the 12th day of March 1783 for the sale of certain lands therein Mentioned. And by virtue of A Commission under the hand and Seal of Office of John Lukens Esq^r Surveyor General for the State of Penn^a to me directed bearing date at Philad^a the 14th day of August 1783 the Above tract of land containing two hundred Acres And Allowance of 6p Cent for roads &c^a was Surveyed on the 6th day of June 1785 by
