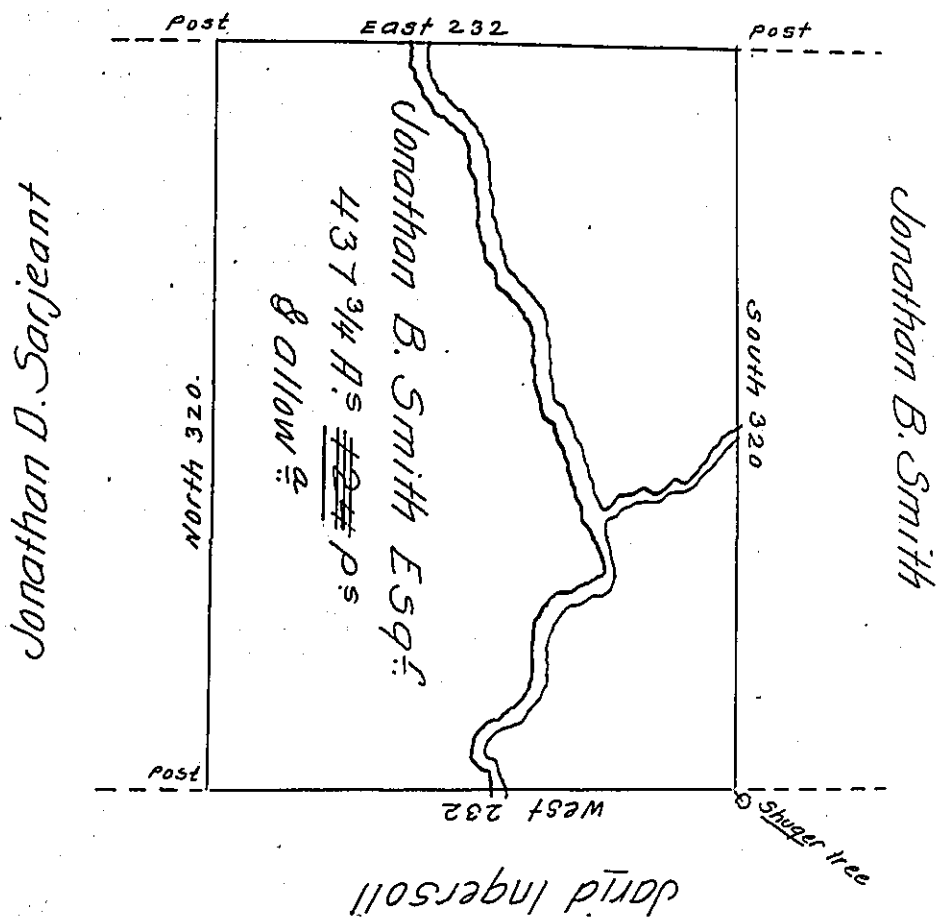


Tim^o Pickering
