Not being possessed of Mr. Lightfoots Field Works, I have this day Run the Lines of the Above described Tract of Land (two, viz, that N. 83 W. 121, and that South 34 Excepted. As the Evening hindred My doing them.) And think I can Safely Certify the Above Draft to be Correct.
