Surveyed for Jacob Fickes the 9th Sep^r 1841 and the 3rd May 1844 on Warrant dated the 7th September 1841 granted to Jonathan W. Fredick for 300 acres

N.B. There is an actual settlement and improvement upon the above tract of land said to have been commenced in 1799 and ever since kept up so I am informed by the said Jacob Fickes. Lafayette Swanagan now lives upon it tenant under the said Jacob Fickes.

Edwin F. Shoenberger on the 11th January 1842 put into my hands a Warrant and Survey made by Peter Gasidy the Warrant dated the 2nd December 1840 granted to the said Edwin F. Shoenberger for 350

acres which said survey includes the whole of the above survey. Reference to the return of said Shoenberger Survey herewith returned will more fully appear.
