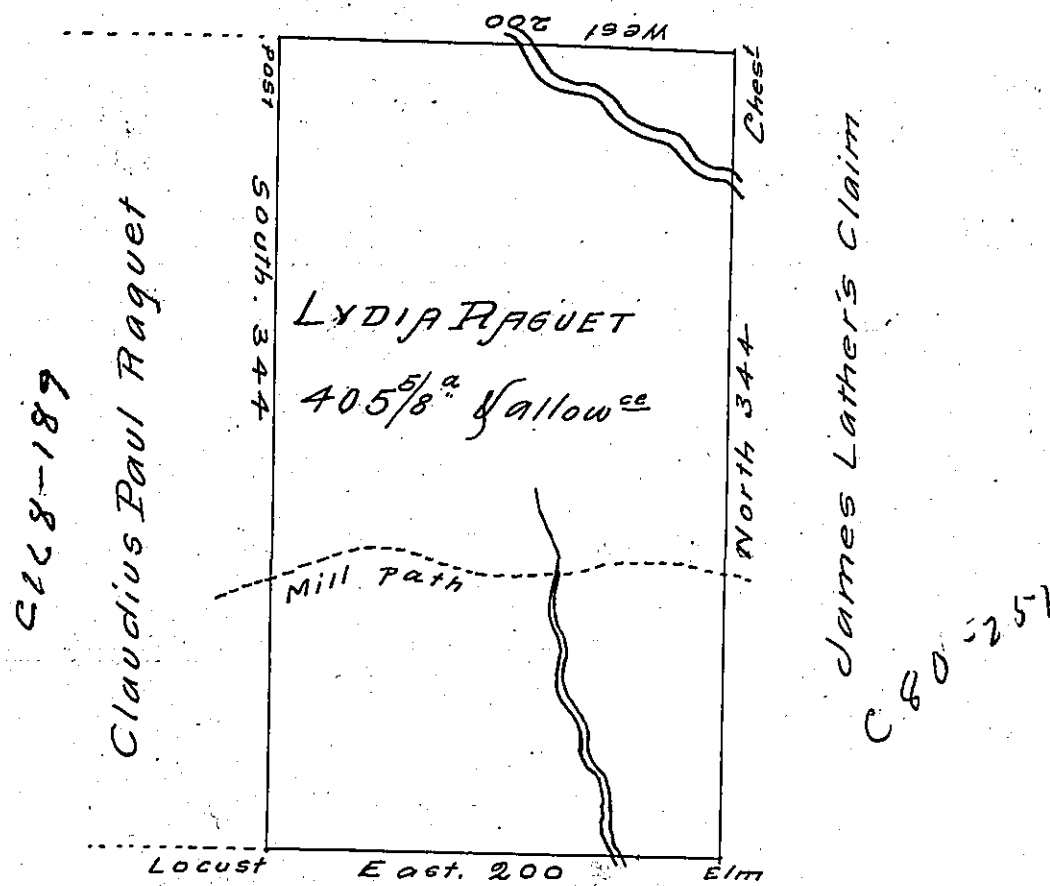


Geo. Steel's claim

Situate on a small Run a branch of Black Lick creek on a Road leading from Brakers Mill to Wallace's Mill bounded by land of George Steel & William Braken in Wheatfield Township Westmoreland County.
