



Situate on the waters of Pine Creek, in Brown Township, Lycoming County,  
 Surveyed to Wendel Sivert, on the 18<sup>th</sup> day of June 1834 by virtue of his  
 warrant for 500 acres, bearing date the 17<sup>th</sup> day of May 1785, containing  
 five hundred & sixteen Acres with allowance of six per cent. for roads & c<sup>o</sup>

This survey is mark'd as being made and returned <sup>by</sup> David Hanna (the  
 then D.S. of Lycoming County) but seems has not been received in the  
 Surveyor General's Office,

I therefore now, at the request of M<sup>r</sup> Geo. Tomb return the same,  
 August 9<sup>th</sup> 1851.
