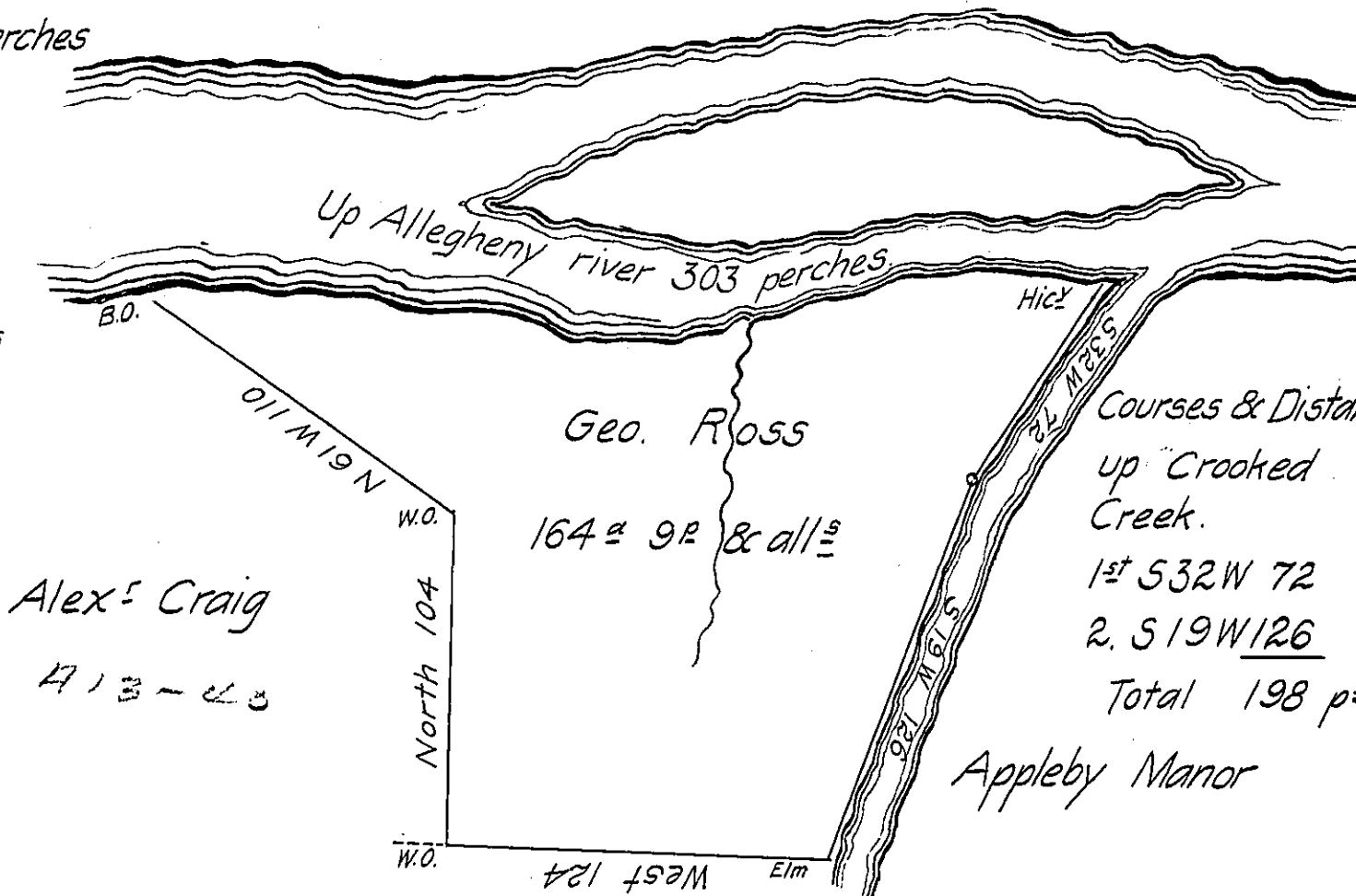

The above is a draught of a Tract of Land Situate in Allegheny Township Armstrong County adjoining Land of Alexander Craig the Allegheny river and Crooked Creek Containing One hundred and Sixty four Acres and nine perches and allowance of Six ~~p~~ Cent for Roads &c. Surveyed the 24<sup>th</sup> day of March A<sup>d</sup> 1830 in pursuance of a Warrant Granted to Geo. Ross dated the 26<sup>th</sup> day of January A<sup>d</sup> 1830 including his actual Settlement & Improvement. ~~p~~ Robert Richards a former Deputy Surveyor taken from his Draught now in my possession which I have examined and find Correct. Certified this 6<sup>th</sup> day of March A.D. 1838.
