



By virtue of two warrants one of them dated the 27<sup>th</sup> May 1747 granted to Peter Rabett the other dated the 21<sup>st</sup> February 1748/9 granted to Peter Haas surveyed the 14 August 1786 to Henry Haas the above two described tracts of land situate in Maccungie township now Northampton County containing in both tracts one hundred and thirty five acres thirty five perches and the allowance of six cent &c.
