



The above is the draught of a tract of land situate on the waters of Fish Pot run, East Bethlehem township in the County of Washington containing ten acres and one hundred and nine poles and allowance &c. surveyed September 20<sup>th</sup> 1837 in pursuance of a warrant granted Jesse Register for himself and in trust &c. dated August 15<sup>th</sup> 1837 on which an improvement was made in the year 1795.
