



Situate in Providence township Bedford County containing one hundred and ten acres fifteen perches and allowance of six per cent for roads & surveyed the 20<sup>th</sup> June 1843 on warrant dated the 6<sup>th</sup> January 1843 granted to the said Allen Ritchey for 100 acres.

N.B. William Grove gave notice when upon the ground that he claimed the above surveyed land by virtue of his improvement that he supposed there were six or seven hundred acres vacant land there, that since he heard that the said Allen Ritchey was getting a warrant, he had run in that part that the said Ritchey had obtained a warrant for that he would not be bound by the original lines of his improvement and requested that it should be so noted on the return of said Allen Ritchey's survey.
