



By virtue of a warrant dated at Philadelphia on the 11<sup>th</sup> day of April Anno 1749 granted to Mandlin Robinalt (alias Robinholder) the above described tract of land situate in Lowhill township in the County of Northampton and Province of Pennsylvania containing ninety four acres and 148 perches of land together with the usual allowance at six percent for roads was surveyed for the Nicholas Fisher as the second husband of the above (obl) med Mandlin Robinalt on the 17<sup>th</sup> day of October Anno 1753.
