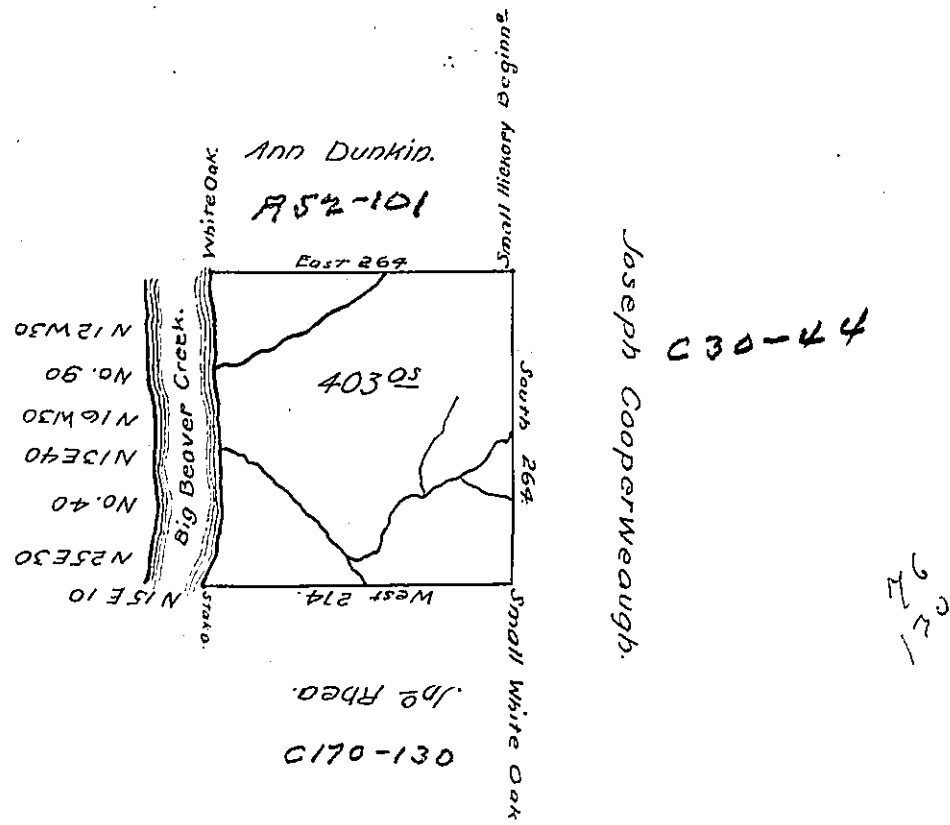

The above is a Draught of a Survey made the 13th of ^{February} ~~April~~ 1795 in pursuance of a Warrant Granted to Edmund Randolph for 400 Acres of Land Dated the 14th of April 1792 Situate North and West of the River Ohio on the East Bank of Big Beaver Creek adjoining Land Granted to Ann Dunkin Called Buxton Containing four Hundred and three Acres with the Usual Allowance of Six per Cent for Roads.
