



In pursuance of a warrant granted to John Wharton, Esq^r for 400 acres dated 14 April 1792, & conveyed to Robert Shannon, & in pursuance of his actual settlement & improvement & residence. There was surveyed on the 4th June 1807, to Robert Shannon the above described tract of Land, containing four hundred and twelve acres & one hundred & twenty four perches and allowance of six per Cent for roads &c.
