Surveyed October 9<sup>th</sup> 1795 by Benjamin Stokely, Late Deputy Surveyor, (as appears by his Official Record remaining in my office) in pursuence of a Warrent granted to Marria Williams Dated the 31<sup>st</sup> of March 1794 Copped from the record and examined by me this 13<sup>th</sup> Day of NOV<sup>r</sup>, 1804.
