



Line betwixt the Depreciation and Donation Land.

A Draught of a tract of Land Surveyed to Alexander Fitchey the 30<sup>th</sup> day of April 1795 but a mistake hapened in one of <sup>the lines</sup> which was corrected Sept<sup>r</sup> 20<sup>th</sup> 1799 in pursuance of a warrant dated Mach 1<sup>st</sup> 1794 BY John Moore, then Deputy Surveyor, containing four hundred and thirten acres and 146 p<sup>s</sup> with an allowance of Six p<sup>t</sup> Cent. Situate in Sugar Creek Township in the county of Armstrong taken from his draught now in my Office which I have examined and finds correct Certified Sept<sup>r</sup> 22<sup>nd</sup> 1810.
