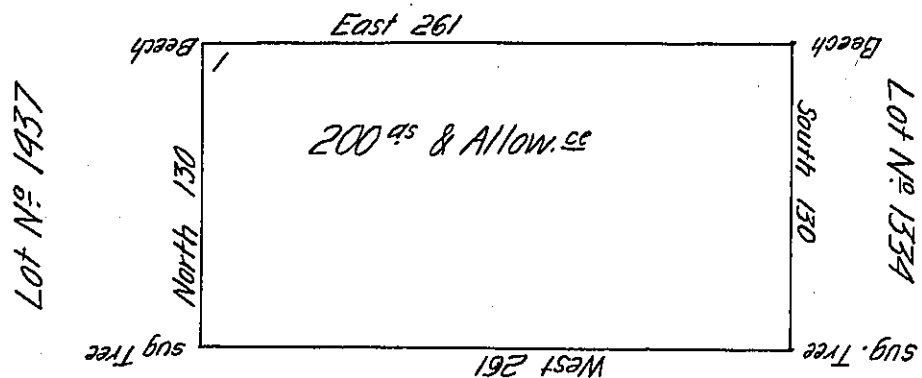

In pursuance of an act of General Assembly of the state of Pennsylvania passed the 24<sup>th</sup> day of February 1785 Intituled an act for directing the mode of Distributing the Donation Lands Promised to the troops Of this Commonwealth & by order of the surveyor Gen. With the Approbation of the Hon<sup>l</sup> the Executive Council I have surveyed on the 17<sup>th</sup> day of Aug<sup>t</sup> 1785 the Above described tract of two Hundred Acres & Allow. of 6 P Cent for Roads &c. N<sup>o</sup> MCCCCXXXIV situate in Dist<sup>o</sup> N<sup>o</sup> 7 on the west side of the Alleg<sup>y</sup> River in the County of Westmorland.
