



In pursuance of a warrant granted to Joseph Stokely Bearing Date the 8th day of October 1811. Surveyed on the 7th Day of November following unto the aforesaid Joseph Stokely the above discribed tract of land containing sixty eight acres and one hundred & seven & one half perches & allowance proportioned at Six Per Cent adjoining land of the widow Mathias, George Cope, Adam Peck, Jacob Cope & Peter Hance, situate in Hempfield township in the County of Westmoreland Including his improvement thereon. Commenced in June 1811 comprehending about half an acre of land Cleared & fenced together with a Dwelling hous- in which Nehemiah Stokely and family now Resides.
