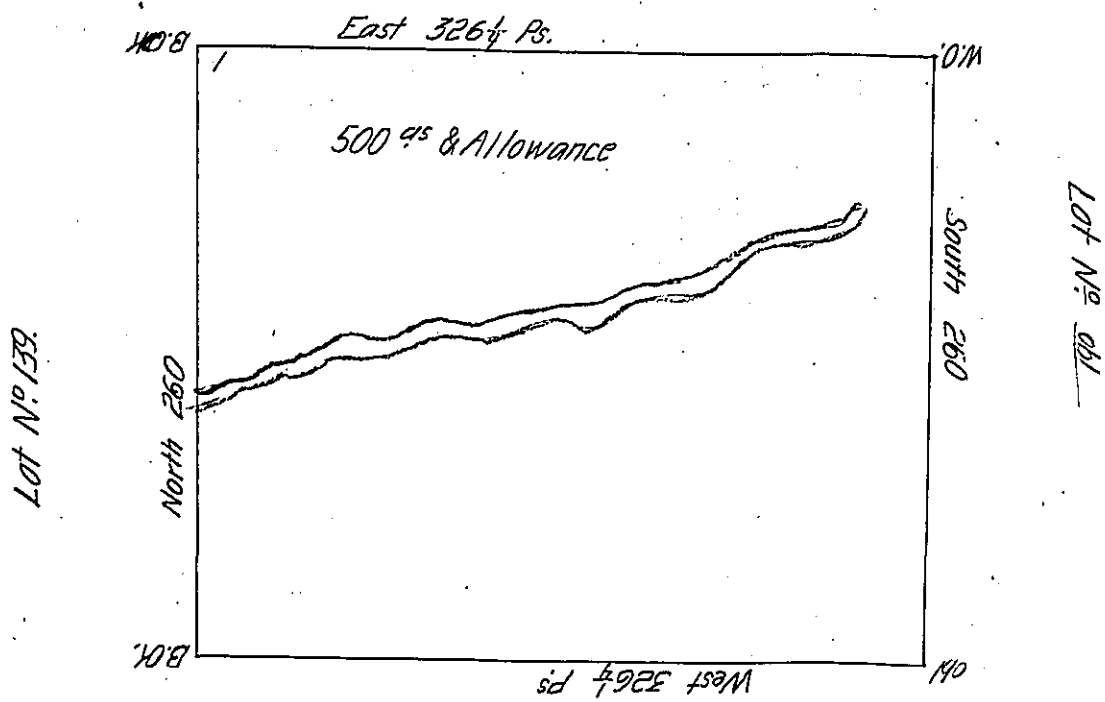

Cent for Road &c. No CXXXI situate In District No 7 on the West side Of the Allegeny River In the County of Westmarland.
