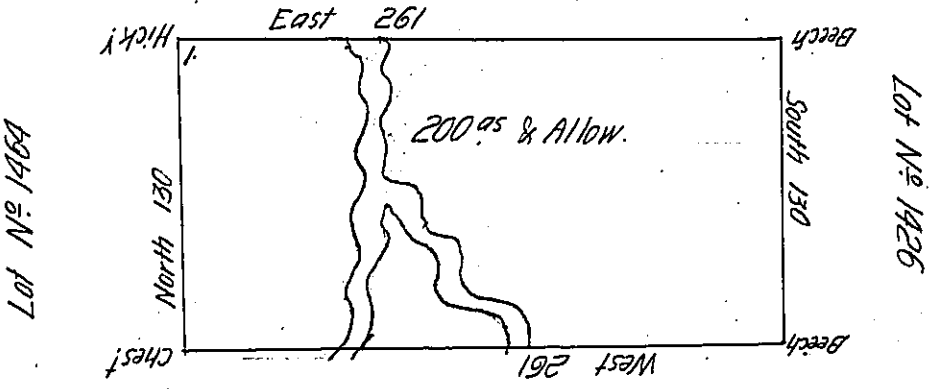

In pursuance of an act of General Assembly of the state of Pennsylvania passed the 24<sup>th</sup> day of February 1785 Intituled 'An act for Directing the mode of Distributing the Donation Lands Promised to the troops of this Commonwealth & by Order Of the surveyor Genl. With the Approbation of the Hon<sup>l</sup> the Executive Council I have surveyed On the 19<sup>th</sup> day of Aug<sup>r</sup> 1785, the Above Described tract of two Hun<sup>d</sup> Acres & Allow. &c. N<sup>o</sup> MCCCXV situate in Dist. N<sup>o</sup> 7 on the West side of the Alleg<sup>y</sup> river in the County Of Westmorland.
