



A Draught of a Tract of Land, situate in Franklin formerly Monaghan Township, in the County of York, on the Bermudian Creek, Containing as above set forth 196° & 122 Perches & all^{ce} & ^c being part of a larger Tract of 221° & 73 Ps. and allowance & ^c of Land, Originally Surveyed by Charles Lukens late D.S. In pursuance of two Warrants both Granted to John Starr one for 100° bearing date the 7th day of April A.D. 1743, and the other for 40° bearing date the 20th day of June 1746. Resurveyed & divided off from the said larger Tract of Land on the 11th day of January A.D. 1812, for and at the request of the owner John Shultz, Who desired the same to be returned for Confirmation.
