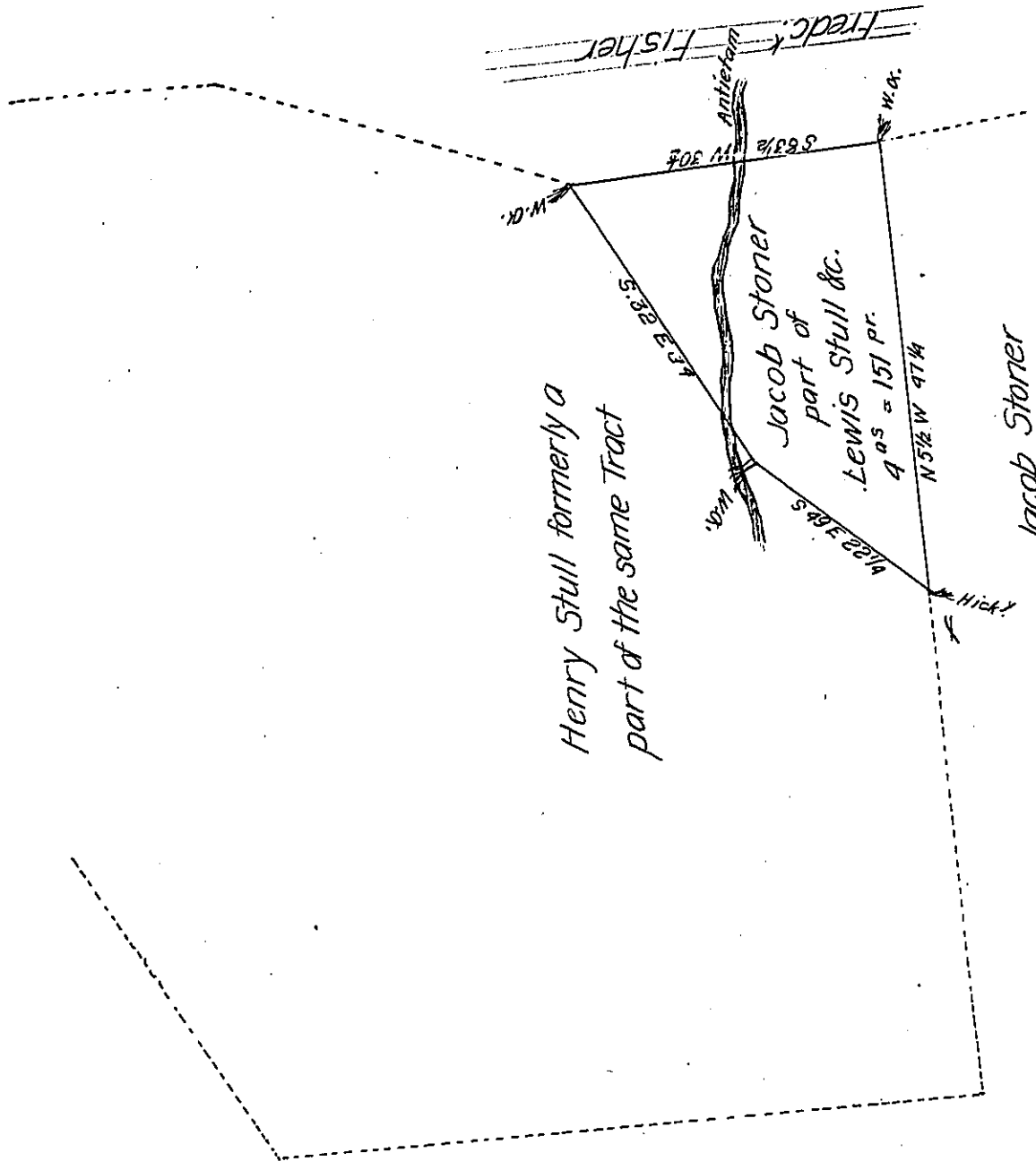

Being part of a Tract of 197^{ac} 90^{pr} & allow^c, which was Surveyed January 22nd 1766 on two Warrants one granted George Stover Dated June 5th 1755 the other granted Lewis Stull dated April 30th 1765 Surveyed and laid off from the other part of the Tract for Jacob Stoner October 17th 1809.
