



Situate in Stoney Creek Township Somerset County Including his Improvement & three runs of Water Emptying into Stoney Creek between one or two Miles from the Great Glade, & Surveyed the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of June 1775 by Alexander M<sup>c</sup>Clean late deputy Surveyor, In pursuance of a Warrant dated the 27<sup>th</sup> day of February 1775 as appears by his Official Draught remaining in my Office, And Certified the 27<sup>th</sup> day of November 1812.
