



Situate on the waters of the Raystown Branch of Juniatta — in Hopewell, — now Broadtop township Bedford County Containing as re-surveyed four hundred and seventy five acres one hundred and forty seven perches and allowance of six per cent for roads &c. Originally surveyed the 29<sup>th</sup> day of June 1794. on warrant dated the 1<sup>st</sup> day of March 1794. granted to Mary Montgomery &c. &c.

The lines carefully reexamined upon the ground in June and July 1853 & 1854 According to the original Marks &c.

And again reexamined the 8<sup>th</sup> February 1855 in pursuance of an order of resurvey granted by the Board of Property to Alexander King Esq one of the executors of John King late of Bedford County deceased. Bearing date the 9<sup>th</sup> day of August 1854. Courses according to the true bearings.
