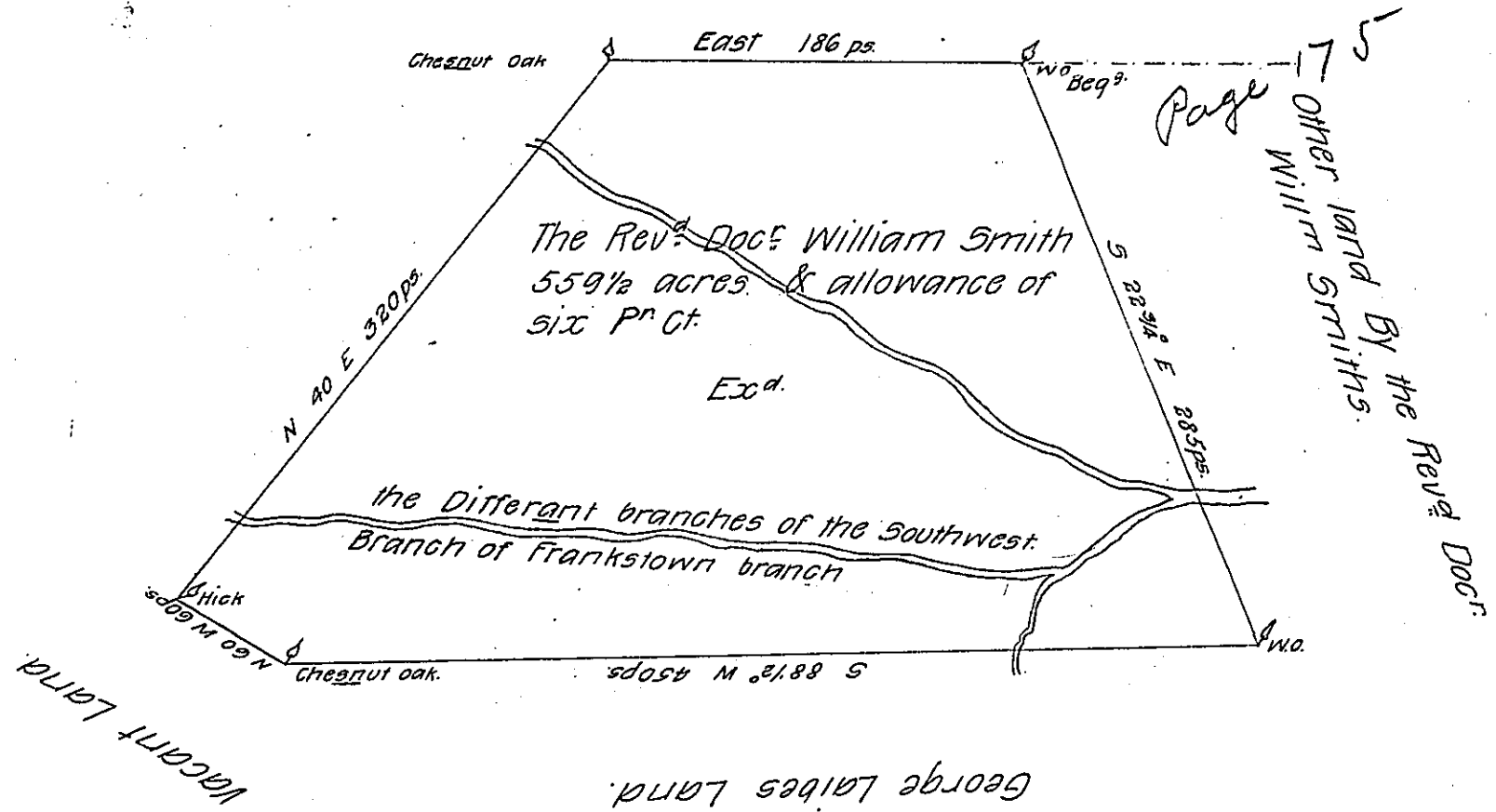


Vacant Hills



A draught of a tract of land situate at a place called the Forks on the southwesterly branch of the Frankstown branch of Juniata—in the county of Cumberland containing five hundred & fifty nine acres & a half and the usual allowance of six P Ct. for roads &c. Surveyed the 18th Octo^r 1765 for the Rev^d Dr^r William Smith in pursuance of a warrant dated the 20th July 1765.
