



By Virtue of a warrant dated at Philadelphia on the 16th day of June Anno. 1753. granted to Martin Shope. The above described tract of land situate in Maccoray Township in the County of Northampton and Province of Pennsylvania containing forty five acres and 95 perches of land, together with the usual allowance at six per cent for roads, was surveyed for the said Martin Shope on the 4th day of September Anno. 1753. (who soon after sold his place with the above said tract to Henry Geiss.)
