



By VIRTUE of a Warrant dated 31st March 1774 was surveyed by Thomas Lightfoot by the order of Charles ~~Lukens~~ ^{Stewart} then Deputy of that District the above described Tract of one hundred & seventy nine acres & 36 P. ^{allowance} to Merrick Star on the 9th day of June 1775 adjoining Land of Star & Lightfoot on the Shamokin Creek near where the Reading Road - crosseth said creek in the valey beyond or on the North of the Mahanoy Mountain in Northumberland County - and Resurveyed by the old lines on the 14th and 15th of November 1805 and examined & Certify'd This 19th of November 1805
