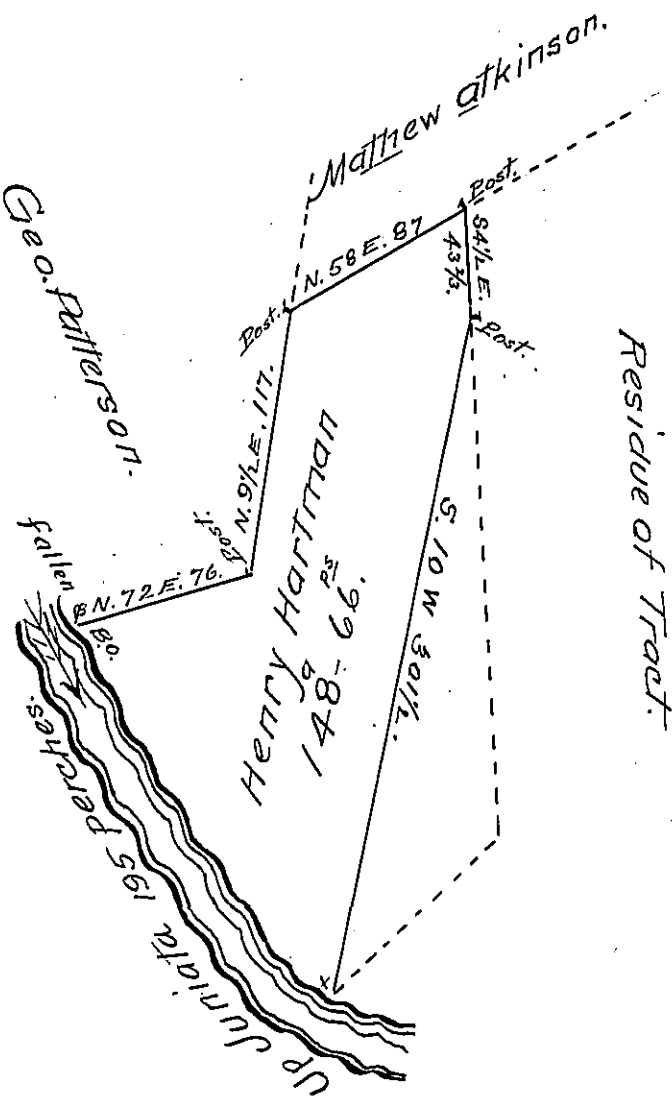

A Draught of one hundred and Forty eight acres and 66 perches and the allowance of six Per Cent. for roads &c. part of a larger tract of Land Situate in Fermanagh Township (formerly Cumb^d) now Mifflin County appears Survey^d. for Valentine Sterne the 31st. of August 1761 - Said to Contain 535/4 Acres and the allowance &c. in pursuance of the Honorable the Proprietaries Warrants one in his own name and one in the name of James Patterson for 150 Acres each - Dated the 6th Day of February 1755

March 17th 1807 Laid off the above part agreeably to lines run for Henry Hartman the 15th day of March 1803 -
 To Samuel Cochran Esquire } P^r. William Harris D.S.
 Survey Gen^l. of Pennsylvania }

Note the angle shown by the Dotted lines on the above includes 50 acres &c. and was a part of Henry Hartmans Claim by virtue of his purchase and at his request laid off the 15th March 1803 for the use of John Faust - P^r. Wm. Harris D.S.
