We the Commissioners for adjusting Claims to unpatented Lands in the Counties of Monogalia Yohogania and Ohio do hereby Certify that Robert Loudon is Entitled to four Hundred acres of land in the County of Yohogania on Montuirs Run to Includ his actual Settlement made in the year one thousand Seven hundred and Seventy three also a Right in Preemption to four hundred acres adjoining thereto - Entry dated 22^d Feby 1780 - Ret'd. 8th Feb. 1786. - Given under our hands at Coxes fort the twenty second Day of February 1780 in the fourth year of the Commonweath.
