

Tenth day of October Anno Dº/1738. I have Survey'd and laid out unto Henry Davis on a Branch of Codorus Creek in the County of Lancaster on the West Side Susquehanna river in right of Mark Harvey Philip Shute One hundred and thirty four acres of land with allowance of Six P. Cent Beginning at a Black Oak a corner of Joh Deardolph's land thence North Sixty degrees Westerly forty perches to a Black Oak thence North thirty Dobres Easterly One hundred and Sixty Perches to a White Oak Thence South Sixty degrees Easterly One hundred and Sixty Perches to a white oak Thence South Thirty deg Westerly One hundred and fourteen perches to a white oak Thence South Thirty deg Mesterly One hundred and fourteen perches to a white oak Thence South Fighty one Degrees Westerly one hundred and Twenty eight Pehes to the Place of Beginning
