From the line trees on the ground around the above survey no certain date can be made out for the same: - inasmuch as there are no two sides of it in which the line is of the same age but it appears that the line on the oldest side was made in 1768 or 1769. - an improvement was begun on it also but I cannot ascertain at what time. - Somewhere about the year 1800 Thomas Godshall and George Wieser two of the claimants under the above right appeared before the Board of Property when a decision was decreed - that the lower half should be Patented to Godshall and the upper half to Wieser which however was not complied with
