



In Pursuance of an Order dated the 31st day of December 1804 I have Resurveyed and divided the above described Lands the 28th day of February 1805 Situate in Upper Sulford Township Montgomery County for the Heirs of John Barkey deceased One hundred and two acres and a Quarter and the allowance of Six P. Cent Surveyed on a Warrant granted to Peter Andreas the 8th day of January 1734 thirty seven acres and the allowance of six P. cent part of a tract of one hundred and fifty nine acres and one hundred and twenty eight perches surveyed on a Warrant granted to Andreas Switzer the 8th January 1734 and Forty one acres and the allowance of Six P. Cent part of a tract of ninety one acres and twenty perches surveyed on a Warrant granted to Christian Boyer the 3rd day of March 1737
