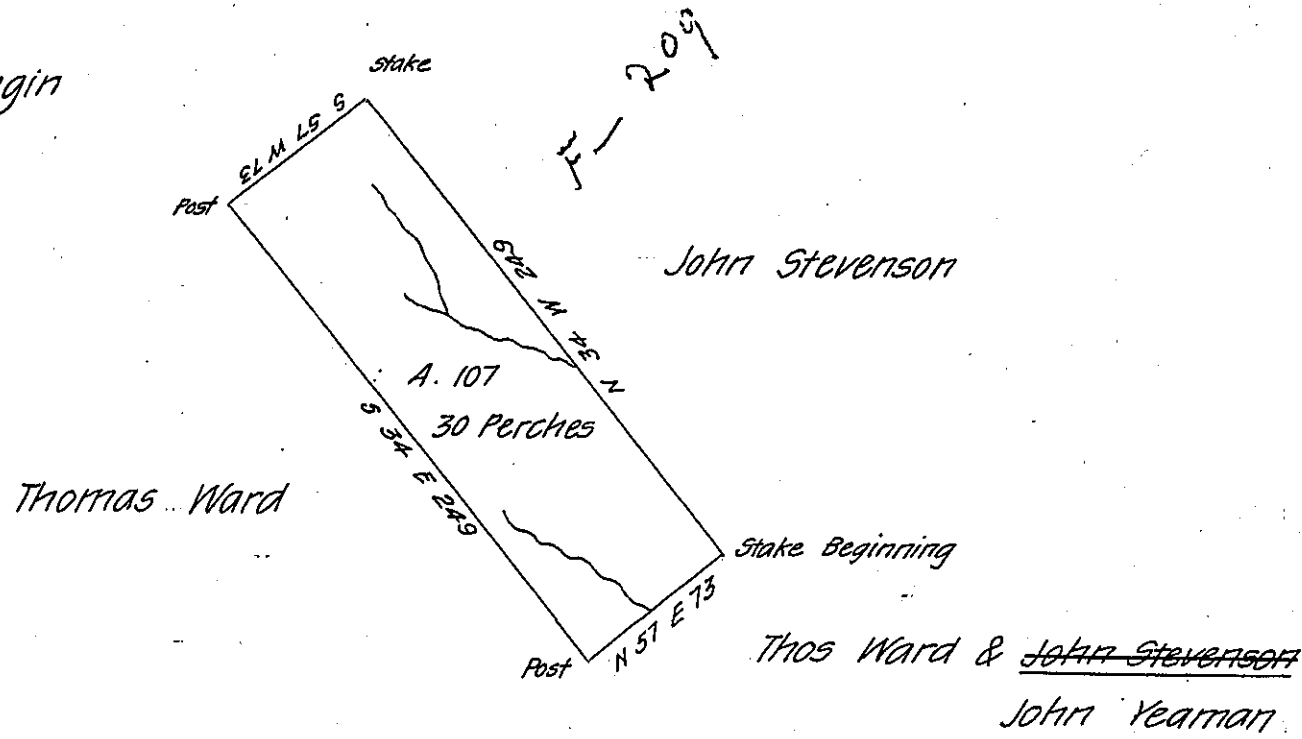


Van Swearingin



A draught of a tract of land surveyed the 14<sup>th</sup> day of November 1805 by virtue of a warrant granted to John Stevenson for 100 Acres dated the 22<sup>d</sup> day of March 1805 Situate on the waters of Cross Creek in Cross Creek Township Washington County Called Dry Nob Containing one hundred seven acres thirty perches together with the usual allowance of Six P<sup>r</sup> Cent for Roads.
