It being part of two Hundred and fifty eight acres and a half of land which was Surveyed unto John Semple in pursuance of his Warrent dated the 16<sup>th</sup> day of May A.D. 1744 by Bartrem Galbraith late Deputy Surveyor of Lancaster County on the 16<sup>th</sup> of December 1780

I do Certify that I have examined and Calculated the Courses & distances round the above Draught find the same Correct and the same quantity of acres aforesaid The Original Survey & Division with a copy of the Warrent directed remaining in my Office March 5<sup>th</sup> 1805
