A draught of a Tract of thirty nine Acres and a Quarter of Land and Allowance having been part of a Tract of 147 Acres of Land Situate on the waters of Swaba Creek Mahanoy Township North^{bd} County Surveyed for Jacob Smith the 9th of January 1793 by virtue of a Warr^t dated 20th August 1792 by W^m Gray then Deputy which has been since Resurveyed and divided by consent of parties between Jacob Smith ~~Junr~~ and the above Andrew Smith and also such parts as had been found to interfere with other rights being cut off by a Resurvey dated the 31st of March 1803 and now examined and Certify'd this 26th of March 1805
