



By Virtue of a Warrant dated the 10th day of November 1772 was Surveyed by W^m McClay then Deputy unto Philip Stover about one half of the above described Tract of One hundred and Sixty three Acres & 29 Perches of Land & Allowance as by a Resurvey the whole tract is found to contain and by virtue of the purchase of Simon Bennidge from said Philip Stoever he said Bennidge went into possession of the whole tract as above described and has ever since the 17th day of May 1786 continued to occupy the same in common with the Residue of the Tract first Surveyed and the whole of said Tract of One hundred and sixty three acres and 29 perches has now April 12th 1805 been Resurveyed all which is certified the said date
